



INSTRUCTIONS FOR INION ARTS FLOWER MAKING RESIN KITS SNOWDROPS

What do I get in my kit?


- 125ml resin – Snowdrop
- 125ml resin – Forest Green or Chartreuse
- 125ml resin - Lime
- 1 bunch of stamens (30+)
- 1 roll of 28 gauge wire
- 1 roll of green floral tape
- 1 small oasis foam round
- 1 set of instructions




What else do I need?

- Mini snippers to cut the wire

What do I do?

Follow our video www.inionarts.co.uk/video.html ***and/or the instructions below***

	Cut 7 pieces of wire about 8" long
	Wind one piece of wire around your finger (one single finger) so that you have one long tail and one short tail
	Twist the two tails together, taking care as the wire is sharp at the end, and slide off your finger
	Make 3 more petals the same way. These are the inner petals.
	Bend the petals as shown in the illustration.
	Dip each petal in the Snowdrop resin. Let it drain over the tin for a few moments. Keep the lid on the resin tin as much as possible to avoid resin thickening.

	Stick each petal in the oasis.
	When dry, dip the end of the petal in the Lime resin.
	Each petal should now have a Lime edging.
	With the 3 remaining pieces of wire, make 3 slightly larger petals by winding the wire around 2 fingers as shown in the illustration.
	You now have 3 outer petals.
	Dip the petals in the Snowdrop.
	Leave to dry in the oasis.
	Take 2 stamens (you can use as many or as few as you like) but we find that 2 stamens work best with such a small flower. Bend them roughly in half so you have a small bunch with 4 ends showing.
	Take one inner petal in your left hand (if right handed) and place the stamens up against it. Place a second inner petal next to it.

	Continue until you have 4 petals together with the stamens in the middle. Take a small piece of tape, and wind round tightly to hold petals together. Petals will move out of position. Don't worry. You can move them back – they are quite robust.
	Take one outer petal and place around the inner petals as shown in the illustrations.
	When you are happy with how the flower looks, wind tape around the wires as long as you want the stem to be. Trim off the end.
	Bend the top of the flower over, to replicate a wild snowdrop.
	Using the green resin, make leaves in the same way, to a size and shape as you wish, and attach to the flower stem with tape.

Congratulations! You have a beautiful, ever-lasting, never fading flower.
